Annual Permit dates run March 1 – February 28 of each year.

The permit should be displayed on the left side of the trailer tongue. If no trailer is used, the permit shall be displayed on the back, left bumper of the vehicle. Please secure the permit firmly. Be sure to sign this application on the signature line above, since this is validation of having received and understood the regulations relating to the use of Twin Springs Park and Boat Launch. Applications without signatures will be returned without being processed. You should receive your permit within 5 working days. Questions, call Town Clerk at 715-247-3470. Photocopying application is okay.

1. A valid parking permit must be displayed on any vehicle parked beyond the gate at all times. Your vehicle will be towed if you do not display a valid permit in the manner explained above.
2. The park is open between 5:00 am and 11:00 pm. All vehicles are subject to being towed if they are in the park after posted hours.
3. No camping, fires, dumping, fireworks, air gun, paint gun, uncased bow, gas operated gun or firearms are allowed in the park. Failure to abide by this regulation will void your parking permit.
4. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed in the park. Failure to abide by this regulation will void your parking permit.
5. This permit is not transferable.
6. No boats will be allowed to attach or tie-up in any manner adjacent to or on the boat ramp except for immediate launch or loading of boats.
7. The Town Board reserves the right to suspend any and all permits.
